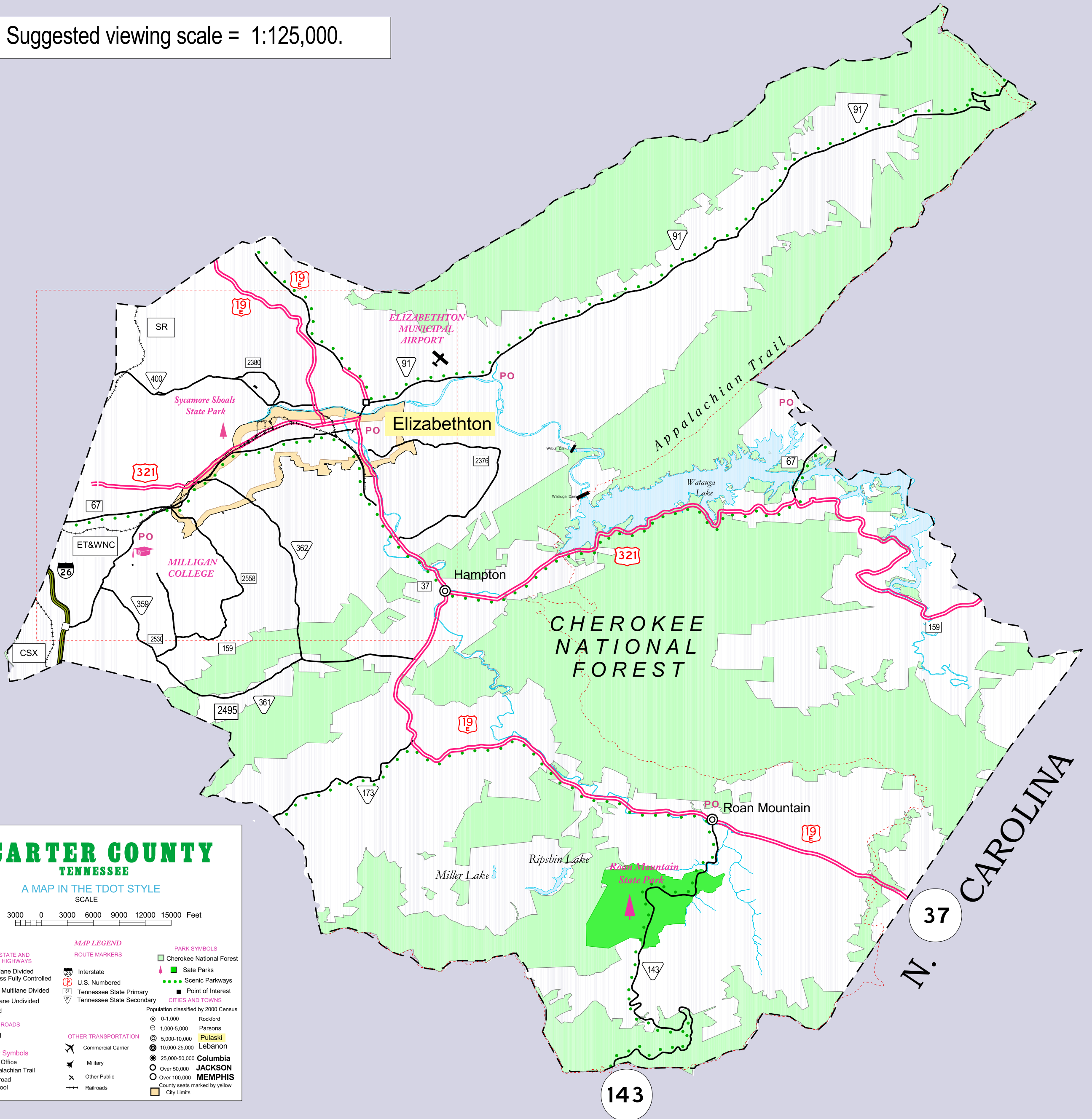


Suggested viewing scale = 1:125,000.



This page in the mapbook is a map of Carter County in the style of a TDOT (Tennessee Department of Transportation) map. The map's purpose is to relate the major roads in Carter County to the national and state highway system. Included are Interstate, state primary and state secondary highways. The map is useful for finding (or avoiding) major traffic areas. For instance, planning a trip to an out-of-state area would allow you to examine the local connections in greater detail than in a national atlas or some state highway maps.

Use the map to avoid heavy traffic during major holidays.

In the upper left corner is a suggested scale for cartographic use. The map was drawn up at a scale of 1:500,000 and the box, when zoomed to, reflects an approximate scale of 1:125,000.

The box in the lower left corner is the map's legend. The legend describes what the various symbols on the map mean. Note the dots represent Tennessee Scenic Parkways and are indicated on highways by a green and white sign with the image of a mockingbird, the state bird. At the time of the making of this map, the logo was unavailable for use in the legend and map.

Most maps are, in general, self-explanatory and easy to use. This one is no exception. We hope you find it useful.
